

CONFIDENTIALITY OF MEMBER ACCOUNTS

In compliance with the ATRS Code of Ethics, the System shall keep confidential all members' salary, employment history, retirement account, and other personal data or information compiled by ATRS for purposes of establishing and maintaining a member's retirement account with the System. Such information shall not be disclosed to any third party without the express written consent of the member or other valid legal process.

NOTE: See A.C.A. § 24-4-1003. Benefit provisions—Inspection of records:

Any and all records kept by an Arkansas public retirement system, whether required to be kept by law or Board policy, shall be open to public inspection as provided in A.C.A. § 25-19-105, except that individual member's records, which are kept for the purpose of compiling information for the member's retirement or social security records, shall not be open to the public.
